Head game scouts states no leopard taken on this concession in last 4 years.

Other hunting group on property tromping through our baited areas, even though I.A.S. and Arnold Payne guaranteed us no one else would be on the property.

Previous hunters just weeks prior hunting leopard in this area after completing their original plains game hunt. Arnold Payne/I.A.S. didn't advise Graham Mayger (P.H.) of this situation.

Arnold Payne/I.A.S. did not offer to come back or try again. No Discount

Arnold Payne/I.A.S. or Tiki Drummond is not returning my email or calls.

Vehicle breaks down, and waited 2 days for vehicle replacement.

No management available during Safari.

Failed to meet contractual agreement.
