I found two cases of this 375 H&H Nosler Brass unuseable but getting 48 is better than nothing which is what I've been able to find until here and now. 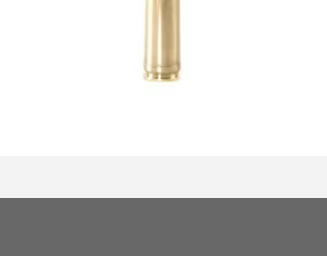
