




Method 18

For Crocodilians, measure to the nearest 1/4 inch or centimetre

Rank on the length.

This is a field measurement, taken before skinning, of the total body length including the length of the tail (A–B). Pull the nose and tail to get them into a straight line, then drive in pegs at the end of the nose and tail. Take the measurements between pegs and NOT by following the line of the body. Measurements should be taken to the nearest quarter inch (or centimeter).

This measurement should be taken by a Professional Hunter or witness, certified by him and by the owner whose trophy has been measured. It should be noted that the Editors will accept measurements of fully mounted specimens using the above system as it has been established that there is very little longitudinal stretching of the skin involved in such cases. Length of raw, cured or tanned skins will not be accepted.
